Bramble

Invented in the mid-80s by Dick Bradsell at Fred's Club Soho London - the ultimate members club of the 80's filled with young famous faces including Boy George, Neneh Cherry, Naomi Campbell & more.

Take a dry Gin, sour it with Lemon, sweeten it with Sugar and flavour it with Blackberries ...the fruit of the bramble, top with crushed ice.

Cosmopolitan

With origins dating back to the 30's, a surge of Cranberry Juice popularity in the 60's, vodka branding wars in the 80's and of course Sex & The City in the 90's... the pink drink, informally a 'cosmo', has stood the test of time, various recipes and numerous claims to its creation.

Made with Vodka, Triple Sec, Cranberry and freshly squeezed Lime juice it's a cert to bring out the fashionista in us all.

Espresso Martini

SoHo Brasserie London 1983, Dick Bradsell is requested by a lady customer for a drink to "wake her up and ...well, 'stimulate' her" with the coffee machine beside the bar being a topic that day the Vodka Espresso was born. A number of variations later and the popularity of a coup style glass attracted the martini (we know it's not a martini) title.

It's all about the Crema. Enhanced by shaking hot Espresso, with Vodka, Coffee Liqueur, Sugar and ice. Embellished with the Italian garnish of 3 coffee beans in a petal shape signifying 'Health, Wealth and Happiness'.

French Martini

A world over crowd pleaser; invented in the 1980s at one of Keith McNally's New York City bars. It next appeared on the drinks menu at McNally's Balthazar in SoHo in 1996.

Again not a martini, it's a simple trio of ingredients popular at the time; Vodka perhaps still enjoying the widest consumer appeal, Pineapple to make it frothy and Raspberry of course ...to make it French. Chambord, black raspberry liqueur has been produced in France since 1685.

Margarita

Margarita: Spanish word for Daisy. The Daisy: a ubiquitous cocktail of the early 20th Century made with citrus juice, sweetened with sugar or liqueur, and mixed with a base spirit; is thought to have attracted its 'happy' Mexican overhaul during prohibition.

The description in a 1953 edition of Esquire as follows... "She's from Mexico, Senores, and she is lovely to look at, exciting and provocative", sat alongside the recipe we use consists of; Tequila, Orange liqueur and Lime juice, shaken with and served over ice in a salt rim glass.

Old Fashioned

Well it is just that... 'old-fashioned'. Much like the glass it is served in harking back to days before the cocktail glass. Formerly known as a Whiskey cocktail, this established drink has up to 6 variants on ingredients and method.

Served on the rocks, it is traditionally made with Bourbon or Rye, lightly sweetened with Sugar, and aromatised with Bitters, it can never be complete without a twist of Orange zest.

Some may add more, but as Crosby Gaige wrote in 1944 "Serious-minded persons omit fruit salad from old-Fashioneds" and we're very serious about ours.

Whisky Sour

Of all the Sours... of which there is a whole family... the Whiskey base thrived during prohibition and proved the most popular and endearing style right up to present day.

Whiskey mixed with lemon juice, sugar, and a dash of egg white otherwise known as a 'Boston Sour'. Or why not have yours with a red wine float making it a 'Claret Snap' aka 'Chicago Sour' aka 'New York Sour'...it's a big family.

WINE

Champagne

Laurent Perrier La Cuvée Brut, France

Well defined, subtly rounded with expressive flavours. The fruit progressively emerges to reveal finely balanced champagne displaying great length on the finish.

Laurent Perrier La Cuvée Rose, France

Well defined and slightly sharp with intense fruity flavours of freshly picked red berries, strawberries, cherries, blackcurrant and raspberries.

Sparkling Wine

Codorníu Brut Rosado, Spain

Light and clear with hints of strawberry and raspberry ending with a clean refreshing finish.

Bolla Prosecco DOCG, Italy

Early harvest preserves the natural acidity in this crisp, sparkling wine. Refreshing on the palate, it has a pale straw colour with clean aromas of lemon, apple and a hint of peach.

Canti Prosecco, Italy

Lively and crisp with delightful flavours of pear and peach. Pale straw yellow in colour with fine and persistent bubbles.

- 200ml single serve -

Red Wine

Montes Merlot, Chile

An elegant wine from one of Chile's top producers. The overwhelming fruit flavour is Dark Plum with hints of other Dark Berries. Some Floral notes help add complexity. Tannins and Acidity are well balanced allowing for a very pleasant experience.

- Also by the glass 175ml & 250ml -

Errazuriz Max Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile

Spicy redcurrant and cassis aromas with cedar, tobacco and musky herbs; really smells like traditional Bordeaux. Firm and focused, with juicy red berry and bitter cherry flavours.

Faustino VII Rioja, Spain

100% Tempranillo, this wine has spent 6 months in American Oak to create an easy drinking, elegant wine. Flavours are ripe red fruits with a little bit of spice and tobacco. An affordable introduction into the wines from this multi award winning producer.

- Also by the glass 175ml & 250ml -

Louis Jadot Pinot Noir, France

An exceptionally elegant pinot with complex aromas of plum, raspberry and cherry. Fresh red fruit flavours in the mouth with earthy, floral and mineral notes and a balanced acidity.

La Finca Celia Malbec, Argentina

Full of Dark Fruit Flavours such as Blackberry and Blackcurrant with hints of Vanilla and Chocolate from barrel ageing. Soft tannins and a long finish make this a very approachable and enjoyable wine. Finca La Celia is the oldest winery in the Uco Valley making this wine packed full of history as well as flavour.

White Wine

Esk Valley Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand

An intense and powerful, full-bodied wine. True to its Marlborough origins it has ripe tropical fruit, citrus and cooler green fruit flavours with fresh herb notes.

Errazuriz Max Reserva Chardonnay, Chile

Floral aromas of ripe apple, apricot, vanilla and a touch of spice combine with the rich apple flavours and crisp acidity. An elegant and impressive wine, showing good acidity and structure.

- Also by the glass 175ml & 250ml -

Lamberti Pinot Grigio Santepietre, Italy

Attractive light floral notes with hints of beeswax, honey and citrus.

A dry well-structured palette that's elegant and fruity with balanced hints of peaches, crushed nuts, some classic melon oiliness and underlying minerality.

- Also by the glass 175ml & 250ml -

Rimat Saira Albariño, Spain

Brilliance, straw yellow with greenish highlights. Mineral aromas appear first, underlain with notes of white flowers, tropical fruit such as mango, stone fruit such as nectarine and a more citrus touch of ripe grapefruit.

A broad wine, full of texture and continental character.

Louis Jadot Macon Blanc Villages, France

Crisp, dry and fresh. Fruity hints of pear and green apple with a long refreshing finish. This unoaked wine has a full and vibrant fruit character.

Rosé Wine

Canyon Road White Zinfandel, California

Light-bodied, cherry and watermelon flavours with hints of strawberry and a smooth crisp finish.

Graham Norton's Own Rosé, Marlborough, New Zealand

Mr Norton decided to expand his portfolio, delivering an off-dry rosé made from Pinot Noir fruit, with delicate strawberry and raspberry notes, juicy fruit flavours and a fresh, lingering finish.
